



Sample application for learning support (tutoring)

Sometimes children need extra support at school. Here is how to apply for learning support:

1. Discussions between parents and teachers.
2. Parents collect the BuT application for learning support from the local social welfare office and fill out the application.
3. Parents go to school with the application and ask the teacher to confirm on the application the need for learning support.
4. Parents return the application to the local social welfare office where it is evaluated and approved.
5. Parents go to school with the approved application and ask about local tutoring options or contact a tutoring institute directly themselves.
6. The social welfare office settles the bill directly with the tutor.

Grants for education and participation in day care, school and leisure activities

BuT

WHAT are BuT services?

Services for education and participation support young people so that they can take advantage of offers in day care, school and their leisure activities.

BuT

WHO receives the benefits?

Children and adolescents up to 25 years of age, whose parents have little money at their disposal and therefore receive benefits from the social welfare office, child allowance or housing benefit.

HOW do I get the benefits?

Please contact the social welfare office in the community where you live.



BuT

WHAT services are available?



School excursions and multi-day class trips

Coverage of costs for group excursions or school trips for children in a day care centre or in a school.



School transport

Bus costs or transport costs for trips to a general or vocational school can be subsidised.



Lunch at school, in day care and in care by a childminder

The cost of communal lunch will be covered.



School supplies

Costs for personal school supplies are subsidised in August with 103 euros and in February with 51,50 euros.



Participation in social and cultural life for young people under the age of 18

For club memberships, swimming courses, music lessons, leisure activities and much more, 15 euros per person are available per month.



Learning support

If students need support to achieve the learning objectives at school, the costs for private tutoring can be covered (see application example for learning support).
